HAWAII KEIKI RODEO ASSOCIATION RODEO RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Rough Stock Events:

- Ribbon Mugging: This event is open to boys and girls with teams of mixed or same gender of girls only.
- Sheep Riding: Participants weigh 50lbs or less at time of event, with gear on or in hand.
- Calf Riding: Participants weigh more than 50lbs, no more than 120lbs and be 13 years old or younger.

****All rough stock participants will be weighed day of event and must come equipped with their own riding gear****

2. ENTRY FORM MUST BE COMPLETED & WAIVER SIGNED BY PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN AND PARTICIPANT.

3. Please ensure the form is completed legibly and that FULL PAYMENT accompany entry, no payment results to no entry.

4. Late entries WILL NOT be accepted.

5. Any scratching or withdrawal of participation must be made by Wednesday at 4:00pm prior to any rodeo date. A full refund minus your \$20.00 office fee will be returned to you.

8. Age Eligibility to Participate:

- Participants must be 18 years or younger and actively enrolled in High School as of August 1, 2025

9. There will be no cancellations of rodeo events. Should Hilo experience consistently excessive rain, outside of it's typical wet weather, that make conditions unsafe for participants and/or livestock a decision will be made to move the rodeo to our scheduled rainout dates: December 20-21, 2025 and/or January 31-February 1, 2026.

LIABILITY WAIVER and PHOTO RELEASE-MUST BE SIGNED

By signing this waiver, I agree to indemnify hold harmless and defend the Hawai'i Keiki Rodeo Association, and the event sponsors for all days of the event for 2025-2026 season it's/their owners, shareholders, limited partners, general partners, heirs, successors, peers, directors, principles, employees, agents, representative and show personnel, from any damages, attorney fees and costs which may incur as a result of my participation as a contestant or a spectator of an event which may cause personal injury or property damage to myself or to any other person or an entity. In the undersigned, understand the Hawai'i Law (Act 249, 1994 Hawaii Legislative Session, effective June 29, 1994) limits the civil liability of persons sponsoring equine activities. I understand there are inherent risks of injury including death when participating in an equine activity (all types of livestock to include but not limited to: horses, cattle, bulls, broncs, sheep), which risks include but are not limited to (1) the propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury or death to persons on or around them, (2) the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sudden movement unfamiliar objects, person, or other animals, (3) hazards such as surface or subsurface conditions, (4) collisions with other equines or objects and (5) The potential negligence of another participant such as falling to maintain control of the equine, or not acting within participants ability. The undersigned agrees that this instrument is a legal contract and is binding on his/her heirs and assigns. I expressly choose to assume these risks further on behalf of myself, my heirs, my successors, representatives, and assigns. I hereby unconditionally release any and all claims and cause of action against equine activity coordinator Hawai'i Keiki Rodeo Association. If the undersigned is the parent, guardian or representative of any minor participating in this equine activity, the undersigned agrees to indemnify the Hawai'i Keiki Rodeo Association, equine activity sponsor (including its/their above described related persons and entities) from any and all claims and cause of action brought by or on behalf of said minor at any time. I also agree to abide by all rules and regulations set forth by the Hawai'i Keiki Rodeo Association.

I hereby Release the Hawai'i Keiki Rodeo Association, the County of Hawai'i, and its employees, agents, contractors, etc. for the irrevocable right and permission to use, publish and exhibit any photographs, videotapes, media, etc. that is taken of me at Hawai'i Keiki Rodeo Association events for 2025-2026 season.
